From Ithaca: NY-13 North Take a left on NY-366 E to Cortland At Rt. 281 take a left. Proceed thru four traffic lights Take your first left after the fourth traffic light onto Kinney Gulf Road (there is a Dialysis office on the corner and a car lot opposite). Go 3.2 miles on Kinney Gulf, The large red barn/tan house on the right after the four way stop is 4588. (you can also take 13 all the way to Cortland and then continue straight onto 281. You would then go through four more lights in Cortland)

From Syracuse: Interstate 81 S to exit 12 Homer Follow signs for Ithaca Make a left at the light at the end of the ramp onto Rt. 281 Go through two traffic lights Before the third light take a right on Kinney Gulf There is a Dialysis office on the corner and a car lot opposite. Go 3.2 miles on Kinney Gulf The large red barn/tan house on the right after the four way stop is 4588

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND TEST INFORMATION

ENTRIES CLOSE at 4 PM, Thursday, September 7, 2017 after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. TD test limited to 8 dogs.

ENTRY FEES are \$65.00 for the Tracking Dog test. This includes the AKC \$0.50 recording fee and \$3.00 event service fee.

EXPRESS MAIL entries must include your signature permitting the envelope to be left at secretary's house without recipient signature.

RECEIPT OF ENTRIES WILL BE CONFIRMED BY EMAIL.

JUDGES CERTIFICATION must accompany all TD entries.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be allowed to participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

DRAWING FOR ENTRIES will be a random draw conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the AKC Tracking Regulations, and will be held at the SOTC, Inc. Training Building at 6392 Deere Rd, Syracuse NY at 7 PM, Thursday, September 7, 2017. Preference will be given to those dogs that have not earned the title for which they are entered. Observers are welcome. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw. Please contact the Test Secretary if you have not received notification with 24 hours of the draw.

ALTERNATES have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those who opt to decline will have their entry fees returned upon providing written notification to the Test Secretary of their intention to withdraw.

WITHDRAWALS will be replaced, if possible, from the alternate list. In the event that an accepted entry cancels after the closing date or is absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order of their placement on the alternate list. Upon such notification the alternates will have the option to accept or decline the opportunity to participate in the test.

REFUNDS will not be issued except for an alternate who does not participate in the test or in the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and is replaced by an alternate, a refund will be made to the withdrawn entry.

DRAWING FOR RUNNING ORDER will be held at 8:00 AM for the TD test on Sunday, September 17, 2017. All entrants must be physically present **at the commencement** of the draw or will be marked absent and an alternate will be allowed to run. The assignment of dogs to the tracks is the responsibility of the judges. Judging is to commence after the draw and as soon as the judges declare the tracks ready.

TRACKING REGULATIONS CAUTIONARY DISCLAIMER Due to the changing nature of the fields being used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public, DOGS SHALL BE ON LEAD at all times on any area of the tracking site. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

THE TEST COMMITTEE AND SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of, any accident or misfortune to dogs or exhibitors participating in this test.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE claims as set forth on the official entry form for this event.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIANS' RECOMMENDATIONS to assure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. New York State law requires that dogs aged four months and older be vaccinated against rabies.

THE CLUB MAY CANCEL the event in the case of extreme weather conditions. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or the grounds and /or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
