

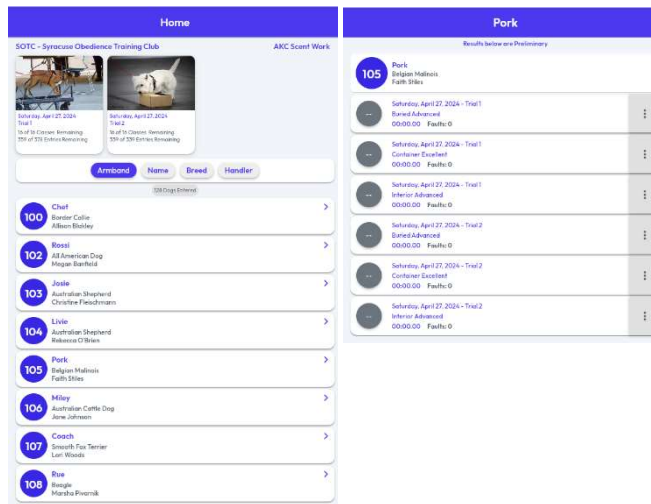
How to Operate the myK9Q app

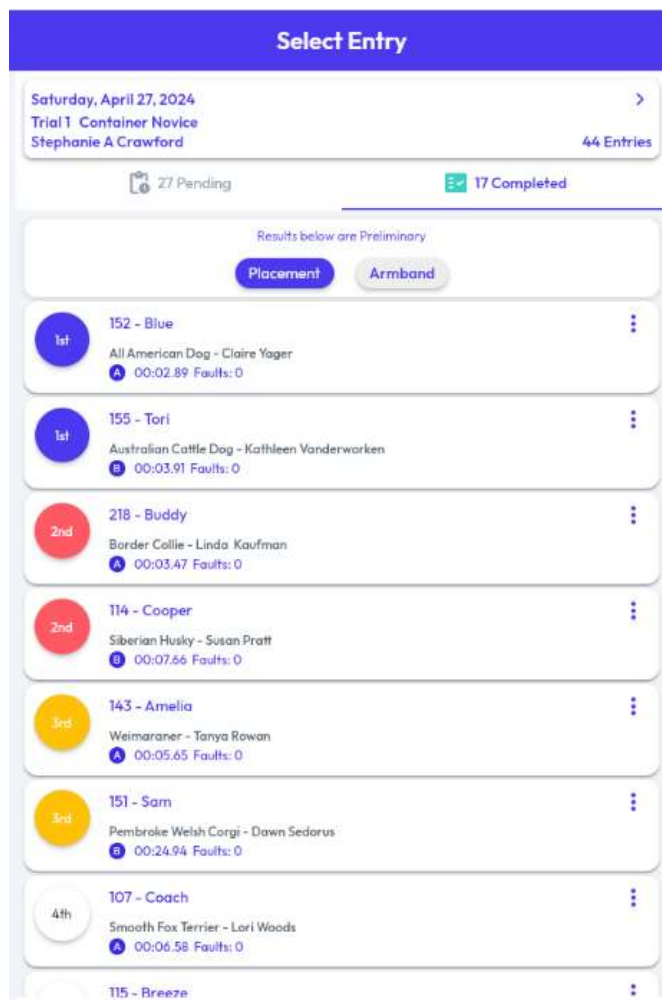


1. Enter the Pass Code which is **e9ff9** which is for **Exhibitors**.
2. The next screen will have the **2 Trials** for the day on top. Under this are all the dogs who are entered for that day for that Trial. To find your dog, you can:
 - a. **Scroll** through all the entries
 - b. **Change the Sort** to **Armband, Name, Breed** or **Handler**.
 - c. Then click on your dog
3. Here you will see everything your dog is entered in.
4. Click the **3 Dots** to the right of one of your entries and you can **Check-In**. You can also let the Gatekeeper know that you are at **The Gate**, have a **Conflict** or click **Pulled** if you've had to pull your dog, by clicking the appropriate link.
 - a. If your dog has already **Competed/run** in any classes, then their **Time, Faults** and **Placement** will show.
5. If you go back to where you see the **Two Classes on the top of the page** and you click one of the **Classes**, you'll see all the Classes for that Trial and what their status is.
6. Click any of the **Classes** and you'll see how many dogs are **Pending** and how many have **Completed**. This is very helpful if your dog is entered in more than one Class and you need to decide which Class to do next.



7. A very neat feature is you can see how many are still **Pending** and how many have **Completed**.

8. And when you click on **Completed**



9. it will show you the **Preliminary Results**. It looks like there are multiple placements, but if you look carefully, since this is for Container Novice, you'll see there's the rankings mixed in together, one for the A class and another for the B class.
