RALLY RELAY. Will be for three dog/handler teams. Four dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. A separate official entry form must be completed for each dog, including the alternate if one is listed. The course will consist of 18 Rally Novice exercises (16 numbered exercises, plus Start and Finish).

The teams will wait near their assigned stations for the pass of a baton, the first team at the Start, the second team at station 6, the third team at station 11. The first team performs the first six stations while carrying a baton. The second team performs station 6 in tandem with the first team as the baton is passed, and the second team then performs stations 7-11. The third team performs station 11 in tandem with the second team as the baton is passed, and the third team then performs the rest of the stations, finishing the course.

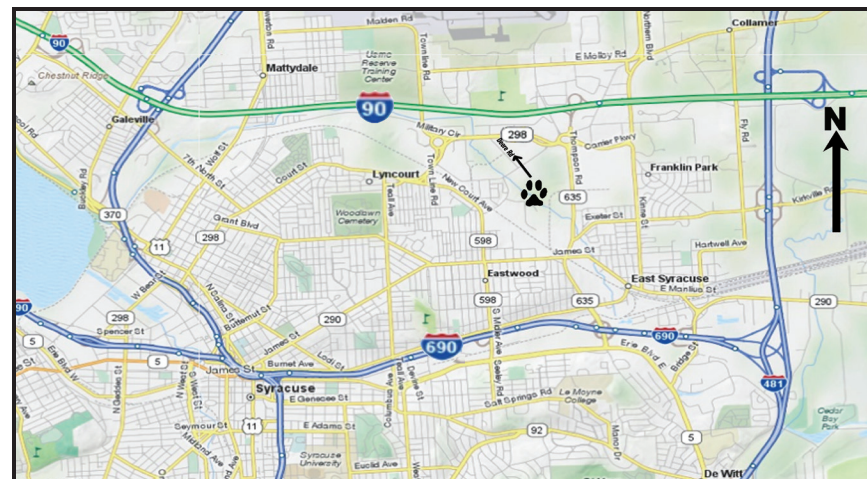

(All fees include AKC recording fee of 50 cents for the 1st entry and an event service fee of \$3.00 for each entry). Junior Handlers (under age 18): reduced fee of \$20 per entry per dog per day. A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, Obedience/Rally trial or Tracking test.
